



Outdoor Lighting Lease Agreement

Wiregrass Electric Cooperative, Inc. (hereinafter called the Cooperative) and _____, a member of the Cooperative (hereinafter called the Member), hereby mutually agree as follows:

Monthly Base Rate Charges:

The Cooperative will furnish and install a sodium lighting unit including ballast with sodium lamp at a location suitable to both parties, will make all necessary electrical connections and will furnish electricity for same which shall be controlled by a photo cell to energize the unit as specified below:

- 100 watt HPS.....\$8.00 per month
- Pole Installation Aid to Construction** for 100 watt\$256.00
- 100 watt decorative.....\$19.00 per month
- 250 watt HPS.....\$18.00 per month
- Pole Installation Aid to Construction** for 250 watt\$208.00
- 400 watt HPS\$22.00 per month
- Pole Installation Aid to Construction** for 400 watt\$315.00
- MV (Mercury Vapor)* 175 watt existing\$10.25 per month
- Additional facilities rental.....\$_____

**Aid to Construction fee may be billed as a contract with a maximum term of twenty-four (24) months. Should request be made to disconnect prior to end of twenty-four month contract, consumer will be billed for remainder of contract.

*Existing light only. Not available for new installations. Lights needing repair will be replaced with 100 HPS open, and then be billed at the 100 HPS rate.

Service is subject to the Rules and Regulations of Cooperative:

1. The Cooperative will maintain the unit during regular working hours of the Cooperative's maintenance or service crew.
2. The member hereby agrees to furnish location for the unit, to permit any tree trimming required for the conductors or unit installation and will pay for the foregoing service at the rate per light per month as specified above and billed with regular electric bill.
3. The member further agrees that the unit, together with the poles and conductors, may be removed at any time by the Cooperative upon failure to pay the charges set forth within.
4. Further the member agrees to protect the unit from damage so far as said member is able.
5. Adjustments:
 - (1) If at any time the rates under which the Cooperative purchases electric power at wholesale are changed, including adjustments in accordance with a fuel cost clause in Cooperative's wholesale power contract, the Cooperative may, at its option, make corresponding changes in the rate for sodium lights as set forth above.
 - (2) Billings under the above rate shall be subject to Alabama State Utility Tax and State Franchise Tax and any new or additional tax or increase of existing taxes imposed by any governmental authority upon the services rendered by the Cooperative.
6. It is mutually agreed that the unit as installed remains the property of the Cooperative and will remain in service for a minimum of one (1) year. *Should request be made to disconnect light prior to end of one-year contract, consumer will be billed for remainder of contract. If Aid to Construction contract is made, should request be made to disconnect prior to end of twenty-four month contract, consumer will be billed for remainder of contract.*
