WHEREAS, Wiregrass Electric Cooperative, Inc. (WEC) is desirous of controlling its wholesale power demand costs; and
WHEREAS, WEC seeks the assistance of its members and contractors in order to assist in controlling demand costs; and
WHEREAS, the undersigned contractor is desirous of participating in this program.
NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions set forth herein the undersigned contractor consents and agrees as follows:

1. Contractor agrees to participate in WEC's load control program and abide by all rules and regulations.
2. WEC agrees to provide contractor with free water heater(s) and have a licensed electrician install its load control equipment on contractor's water heater(s) at no cost to contractor.
3. The undersigned contractor understands and agrees to inform purchaser that WEC will control the times at which the water heater(s) will turn on and off in order to better manage WEC's demand cost.
4. WEC agrees to use its best efforts to manage this load control equipment in such way as to cause minimal or no inconvenience to resident.
5. WEC and contractor agree to cooperate in good faith in order to reduce WEC's demand cost and to do so with minimal or no inconvenience to resident.
6. Contractor agrees to inform purchaser of installation of load control equipment and transfer to purchaser of agreement to participate in the program for a minimum of two (2) years and further agrees that unless the purchaser provides WEC with written notice of desire to terminate this agreement that it shall automatically renew hereafter.
7. Participation in this program shall be at no additional cost to contractor or purchaser.
8. Building contractor/vendor's failure to honor the terms and conditions of this agreement, including the contractor/vendor's failure to ensure a WEC specified load management device is installed on the "free" water heater(s) before the sale of a home occurs, may result in WEC billing the contractor/vendor the expense of the "free" water heater(s) and possible additional fees related to WEC's expense of broken agreement.
